Getting Started

There are no limitations to the number of titles you can download and you can keep them on your device until you decide to delete them. The website is powered by Zinio.

New customers – Go to eMagazines and click on '**create new account**' you will be asked to enter your library barcode, which is on the back of your library ticket.

Next Step - You now will be asked to create your own account.

Type in your name, email address and a password.

Please remember your account details – this is what you use when you are asked to enter your login details. **Do not use your library card number once you have created your own account.** This is only used once when you first create your account.

Next step - select your choice of titles and go to **checkout** and follow the login details using your account detail.

Go to **start reading and** enter your account details

Go to **continue**. This automatically directs you to the zinio.com site.

*You can now start reading your magazine on a PC. However, if you are using an iPad, Android or Apple devices you will need to download the Zinio app in order to read your magazine their browsers do not support Zinio magazines. However you can view them using the Zinio app.

Download the Zinio Reader app

Open the Zinio Reader app.

Enter your username and password.

Go to the book icon.

You can now see your reading list and titles you have selected.

From here you can go to your chosen title and start reading.

***Please note** if you are using Zinio app you will still need to go to Derby City Libraries to download your magazines. Once you have downloaded them onto your device, then you go to the Zinio app to read your selected titles.

Returning customers - Enter your registered email address and registered password and go to 'Log In'.

In order to return to the library's collection platform go to 'Return to Library Collection' tab on your browser.
