YOU WILL NEED...




- Two large plastic bottles
- Two disposable drinking cups
- One piece of cardboard
- Red and orange crepe paper or streamers
- Two long pieces of ribbon
- Sellotape or glue
- Scissors
- Tin foil or silver paint
- Decorations e.g. paint, stickers, pens

# HOW TO MAKE YOUR SUPERHERO ROCKET PACK

Recycling superhero, Recycler Robbie needs to get up Trash Mountain in a hurry to make sure the evil villain, Landfil Larry, is recycling! How can he do it? With a rocket pack!

Keep reading to find out how to make your own so you can rocket round and collect recycling in your home.

1. Robbie looked around the house and found two empty pop bottles. He removed the labels and lids for his rocket fuel tanks.
  2. Next he got a piece of cardboard to be the rocket pack frame. He used some tin foil from the kitchen cupboard and covered the rocket pack frame.
  3. Recycler Robbie then used black tape for extra speed stripes on the fuel tanks and made some super stars out of paper. To make sure he could fly his rocket, he used the bottle tops to make control knobs on the fuel tanks.
  4. Next, Robbie needed some rocket fuel flames for his fuel tanks. He used some red, orange and yellow tissue paper and attached the flames to the bottom of his fuel tanks.
  5. When Robbie was happy with his fuel tanks, he attached them to the shiny rocket pack frame with some glue.
  6. The final step was to make sure the rocket pack would stay on Robbie's back when he flew up Trash Mountain. To do this, he used two shoelaces (you could use ribbon) as straps, attaching them to each side of the rocket pack frame.
